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From the Founder:

“We can help our children learn by igniting their love of learning through creating curiosity and a spirit of enquiry in them, an appetite for learning, a hunger for knowledge. If we can kindle this, it is enough: whether we teach them something or not, the child will learn, anybody will learn. This is the key, the formula. Into this formula everything fits that has been researched and said about teaching: inducing and infusing curiosity. If curiosity is there, observation will naturally come. You can’t simply ask children to observe nature. They will observe and think, “Okay, we are observing, so what?” Because that also is simply following an instruction. Observation like this doesn’t serve the purpose. First, curiosity should be there. Then observation makes sense and serves the purpose.”



“What I am saying is, we should infuse the child with a spirit of enquiry. Even when we want him to learn a particular thing, we should begin by asking a question that creates curiosity in the child’s mind – like the state of mind of a scientist before he makes a discovery. Especially in the natural sciences and mathematics, where many discoveries have been made, this would be easy to implement. First, motivate the child with questions that make him puzzled about something – his mind should always be puzzled. Then start giving answers to the questions which you yourself have created. By posing questions, that make the child wonder, “what would be the answer?”, interest in the answer is created. Then, when you give the answer, it is like giving food to a hungry person, not simply dumping information he won’t take because it’s not needed!”



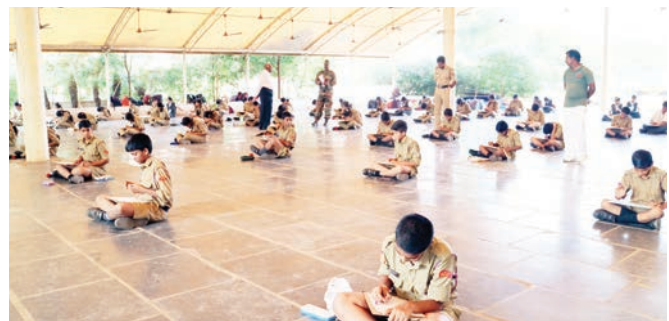
CLIMATE ACTION CONTEST

The 34th NCC Andhra Battalion, Ongole organized a Climate Action Contest for the students with a view to make the world a better place. These contests were being organized in collaboration with the 'Society to uplift the Masses', an NGO on special consultation status with ECOSOC of the United Nations, as a part of our celebrations of World Human Rights Day (December 10) and National Consumer Day (December 24). 'Climate Action' is currently engaging the attention of the entire world. It is an important component of 'Sustainable Development Goals', recently finalized by the United Nations Organization.

Our School students took active participation in the Slogan Contest on the theme 'Say NO to Electronic Waste.' They also took part in a painting competition on the theme 'Global Warming and Survival' and an online photography contest on the theme 'Flora and Fauna of India' through Facebook. It was decided that ten best entries for painting and slogan contests would be selected and sent to the authorities concerned by 31 December and the selected candidates would be suitably rewarded.

As regards the online contest, the photos sent by the students along with their particulars would be adjudged on the basis of number of 'likes' earned by them. Minimum number of 'likes' required for the prize was 25.

These contests were organized in the School under the supervision of the Principal, Col. C V Ramanayya, School NCC officer, Mr Sudarsan, The Commanding Officer of the 34th NCC Andhra Battalion, Lt. Col. Abdul Rahim and BHM Sagainadhan.



PRESENTATION ON POLLUTION - CLASS - V

The School organized a presentation on 'Pollution' by class V students on 21 October 2016. The venue, Babuji hall, was decorated attractively with colorful charts, pictures and slogans and other requisite information on the topic. Many parents attended and witnessed the programme.

A group of students from class - V enumerated the various types of pollution and their causes and also the adverse consequences that endanger the biosphere. Another group of students had a thorough discussion on the natural and man made sources of pollution and the remedial measures to be taken to curb or minimize pollution. They detailed the harmful effects of various effluents.

The students enacted hilarious skits in Telugu showcasing various types of pollution and suggested remedial measures to be taken to overcome the menace. Inspiring video clippings on the causes and effects of pollution were also shown to the audience.

The students spoke about air pollution, which is a world wide growing threat to human health and also the natural environment. Air Pollution occurs when gases, dust particles and smoke are introduced into the air. Carbon dioxide is one of the most harmful poisonous gases and is formed when carbon is not burnt completely. They further added that pollution is caused by both natural and man-made sources.

The natural causes of pollution are acid rain, forest fires, volcanic eruption, dry soil erosion, etc.

The man made causes are construction or demolition, urbanisation, industrialisation, deforestation and vehicular exhaust.

Both are serious threats to all forms of life. Children in areas exposed to air pollutants commonly suffer from pneumonia and asthma. Air pollution also results in cancer, bronchitis, dust allergy and other lung diseases. It spoils rivers, land and environment, which deplete the ozone layer.

Some students had a thorough discussion on the contamination of water bodies such as lakes, rivers, oceans, aquifers and groundwater. They stated that this form of environmental degradation occurs when pollutants are directly or indirectly discharged into water bodies without adequate treatment to remove harmful compounds and this effects the plants and organisms living in these water bodies.

In almost all cases, the effect is damaging not only to individual species and population, but also to the natural biological communities. It has been suggested that water pollution is the leading worldwide cause of deaths and diseases.

The specific contaminants leading to pollution in water include a wide spectrum of chemicals, pathogens, and physical changes such as elevated temperature and discoloration.

The students said that sound pollution or noise disturbance might harm the activity or balance of human and animal life. The source of most outdoor noise worldwide is mainly machines and transportation systems. Noise can have a detrimental effect on all forms of life.

It is no exaggeration to say that the students executed the show splendidly and succeeded in bringing adequate awareness among one and all.

The Hon. Correspondent, Major Suresh Babu and the Principal Col. C V Ramanayya witnessed the programme and appreciated the students for their active participation and splendid performance. The management thanked the parents for gracing the show. Some parents took the initiative to express their opinion on the show and appreciated the students for executing the show meticulously. They also awarded the participants with participation certificates.



INAUGURATION OF THE NEW SCHOOL BUS

Without fast and legible handwriting, students will miss out on learning opportunities, under-achieve and may fall behind.

ధైర్యసాహసాలకు మారుపేరు హవల్దార్ జగదీష్ చంద్

భారత వైమానిక స్థావరాల్లో పంజాబ్ లోని పఠాన్ కోట్ ఎయిర్ బేస్ కు చాలా ప్రాధాన్యత ఉంది. ఉగ్రవాద కార్యకలాపాలను అణిచివెయ్యటంలో ఇది ఎంతో కాలంగా కీలకమైన పాత్ర పోషిస్తోంది. పాక్ ప్రేరేపిత ఉగ్రవాద సంస్థలు పంజాబ్ లోని వివిధ ప్రదేశాలపై గడచిన దశాబ్దంనూర కాలంలో 7 పర్యాయాలు పంజా విసిరాయి. ఇటీవల 2016, జనవరి 2వ తేదీ అర్ధరాత్రి పఠాన్ కోట్ ఎయిర్ బేస్ పై ఉగ్రవాదులు జరిపిన దాడి మన దేశాన్ని తీవ్రంగా కలవరపరచింది. ఈ దాడి జరిగినప్పుడు హవల్దార్ జగదీష్ చంద్ ప్రదర్శించిన ధైర్యసాహసాలు, సమయస్ఫూర్తి ఆశ్చర్యానికి గురిచేస్తాయి. ఆ సమయంలో తాను నిరాయుధుడై ఉండి కూడా, ప్రాణాలకు తెగించి ఉగ్రవాదులతో వీరోచితంగా పోరాడిన ధైర్యశాలి, సైనికోత్తముడు, వీరశ్రేష్ఠుడు జగదీష్ చంద్. సైనికుల వారసత్వాన్ని పుణికిపుచ్చుకున్న వ్యక్తి. అతని తండ్రి, అన్నగారు భారతీయ సైన్యంలో పనిచేశారు. జగదీష్ తన 19వ ఏట 1985లో భారతీయ సైన్యంలో జవానుగా చేరాడు. డోగ్రా రెజిమెంట్ లో 25 సంవత్సరాలు ఎంతో క్రమశిక్షణ, అంకిత భావంతో దేశసేవ చేశాడు. హవల్దారుగా 2009లో పదవీ విరమణ చేశాడు.

సాధారణంగా పదవీ విరమణ చేసిన జవాన్లు, సైనికోద్యోగులు తమ సర్వీసు ఆధారంగా ఏదైనా సివిల్ ఉద్యోగం చేసుకుంటూ హాయిగా కాలక్షేపం చేస్తారు. కానీ జగదీష్ చంద్ కు మాత్రం అలాంటి జీవితం గడపాలనిపించలేదు. రెండున్నర దశాబ్దాల పాటు దేశానికి చేసిన సేవతో అతను తృప్తి చెందలేదు. కొద్ది నెలలు భార్యాపిల్లలతో స్వగ్రామంలో విశ్రాంత జీవితం గడిపిన పిమ్మట హవల్దార్ జగదీష్ చంద్ 2010 లో డిఫెన్స్ సెక్యూరిటీ కోర్ లో చేరాడు. తనకు అవకాశం ఉన్నంత వరకు దేశసేవ చేస్తూనే బ్రతకాలనేది జగదీష్ ఆశయం. సర్వీసులో మంచి రికార్డ్ కలిగిన మాజీ సైనికుల సేవల్ని వినియోగించుకునే డిఫెన్స్ సెక్యూరిటీ కోర్ (డి.యస్.సి) భారత వైమానిక దళ స్థావరాల రక్షణ బాధ్యతలు నిర్వహిస్తుంది.

జగదీష్ చంద్ ను 2015 డిసెంబర్ లో పఠాన్ కోట్ ఎయిర్ బేస్ కు ట్రాన్స్ ఫర్ చేశారు. పఠాన్ కోట్ వెళ్ళి డ్యూటీలో చేరే ముందు జగదీష్ చంద్ 10 రోజులు శిక్షణ తీసుకుని, స్వగ్రామం వెళ్ళి భార్యా- పిల్లలతో ఆనందంగా గడిపాడు. పఠాన్ కోట్ ఎయిర్ బేస్ పై ఉగ్రవాద దాడి జరగటానికి ఒక్క రోజు ముందే, జనవరి 1వ తేదీన ఆ వైమానిక స్థావరంలో బాధ్యతలు చేపట్టాడు.

పఠాన్ కోట్ ఎయిర్ బేస్ భారత వైమానిక స్థావరాలన్నిటికీ తలమానికంవంటిది. పాకిస్తాన్ సరిహద్దుకు కేవలం 35 కి.మీ. దూరంలో ఉన్న ఆ వైమానిక స్థావరం భారత్ కు వ్యూహాత్మకంగా అత్యంత కీలకమైనది. అది ఆసియాలోనే చాలా పెద్ద ఎయిర్ బేస్. సుమారు 2,000 ఎకరాల్లో, 24 కి.మీ. చుట్టుకొలత కలిగిన అత్యంత ఆధునికమైన ఫార్వర్డ్ బేస్ అది. ఆ స్థావరంలో 8900 అడుగులు పైగా పొడవున్న 'రన్ వే' పై మన యుద్ధవిమానం ఏదైనా ల్యాండ్ కాగలదు, టేకాఫ్ తీసుకోగలదు. ఆ ఎయిర్ బేస్ నుంచే పాక్ సరిహద్దు వెంబడి ఎయిర్ పెట్రోలింగ్ నిర్వహించబడుతుంది.

పాక్ చొరబాటుదార్లను నిలువరించటంలో ఎయిర్ పెట్రోలింగ్‌దే కీలక పాత్ర. ఒకవేళ పాక్ సరిహద్దులో ఏదైనా ప్రమాదం ముంచుకొస్తే, పరాన్‌కోట్ వైమానిక స్థావరం నుంచి బయలుదేరిన బాంబర్ కేవలం ఒక నిమిషంలోనే సరిహద్దు ప్రాంతానికి చేరుకోగలడు.

పరాన్‌కోట్ వైమానిక స్థావరం అత్యంత కీలకమైన సాంకేతిక సామగ్రి ఉంచే ప్రదేశం కూడా. అందులో మిగ్ 21 జెట్ ఫైటర్స్, ఎం.ఐ-35 యుద్ధ హెలికాప్టర్లు, బాంబర్లు, యుద్ధసంబంధమైన ఆధునిక సాంకేతిక పరికరాలు ఉంటాయి. అంతే కాకుండా అదే ప్రాంగణంలో 3,000 క్వార్టర్లలో సైనికుల కుటుంబాలు కూడా నివసిస్తూ ఉంటాయి.

పరాన్‌కోట్ వైమానిక స్థావరంలో తీవ్రమైన విధ్వంసం సృష్టించి, మన దేశాన్ని చావు దెబ్బ తియ్యాలనే లక్ష్యంతో వ్యూహాత్మకంగా జరిపిన భయంకరమైన ఉగ్రవాద దాడి ఇది. నూతన సంవత్సరారంభాన్ని ఈ దాడికి ముహూర్తంగా నిర్ణయించింది పాకిస్తాన్. సుశిక్షితమైన ఆరుగురు ఉగ్రవాదులు చాకచక్యంగా మన సరిహద్దును దాటుకొని, ఎ.కె.47 తుపాకులు, మోర్టార్లు, గ్రేనేడ్ లాంచర్లు మొదలైన అత్యాధునిక ఆయుధాలు; గ్లోబల్ పొజిషన్ సిస్టమ్‌లాంటి సాంకేతిక పరికరాలతో జనవరి 2వ తేదీ రాత్రి పరాన్‌కోట్ వైమానిక స్థావరంలోకి చొరబడ్డారు. మన మిగ్-21 యుద్ధ విమానాల్ని ధ్వంసం చెయ్యటానికి పెద్ద ఎత్తున RDX కూడా మోసుకొచ్చారు. వాళ్ళు ఆత్మాహుతి దాడులకు సిద్ధపడి వచ్చారు.

జనవరి 1వ తేదీన పరాన్‌కోట్‌లో డ్యూటీకి రిపోర్ట్ చేశాడు హవల్దార్ జగదీష్‌చంద్. 3వ తేదీ తెల్లవారుజామున ఎయిర్‌ఫోర్స్ సిబ్బందికి అల్పాహారం సిద్ధం చేయించే పనిలో నిమగ్నమై ఉన్నాడు. సుమారు 3.30 గం||ల సమయంలో అకస్మాత్తుగా భోజనశాల బయట తుపాకీ పేలుళ్ళు వినిపించాయి. కిటికీలోంచి తొంగిచూస్తే మసక చీకట్లో మన సైనిక దుస్తుల్లో ఎ.కె. 47 చేతపట్టుకొని, లైట్లు వెలుగుతున్న మెస్‌వైపు గుళ్ళవర్షం కురిపిస్తున్న వ్యక్తి జగదీష్ కంటపడ్డాడు. అతడు పేలుస్తున్న రైఫిల్లో నుంచి గుళ్ళు మెస్‌వైపు దూసుకు వస్తున్నాయి. 'వైమానిక స్థావరంపై ఉగ్రవాద దాడి జరిగే ప్రమాదం పొంచి ఉంది' అని నిఘావర్గాలు చేసిన హెచ్చరికలు జగదీష్‌కు జ్ఞాపకమొచ్చాయి. అనుమానం లేదు. వాడు తీవ్రవాదేనని గ్రహించాడు. ఆ సమయంలో ఆయనవద్ద ఏ ఆయుధమూ లేదు. దొరికే అవకాశమూ లేదు. ఆయుధం కోసం ఆలోచించే వ్యవధిలో ఆ తీవ్రవాది ఏ వినాశానికైనా ఒడికట్టవచ్చు. ఆ ముప్పురుణ్ణి యుద్ధవిమానాలు, హెలికాప్టర్లు ఉండేవైపు వెళ్ళనిచ్చినా, సైనికుల క్వార్టర్లవైపు పోనిచ్చినా పెనుప్రమాదం తప్పదు. అప్పుడు జగదీష్ చంద్ సాహసమే ఆయుధంగా, దేశభక్తి చోదకశక్తిగా సాయుధుడైన ఆ శత్రువును నిరోధించడానికి పూనుకున్నాడు.

Finally, I conclude that being a doctor is not great, being a noble doctor is the highest. I wish my sweet dream to become a doctor would be fulfilled.



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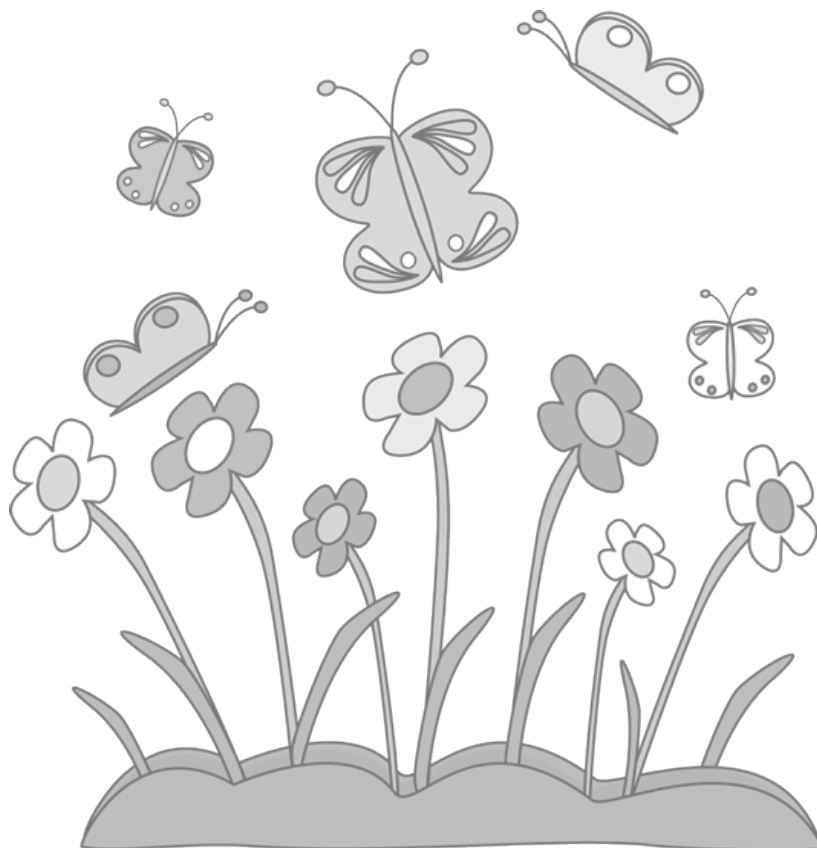
Smile
